

Child Development and Care: Subject Revision Guidance

We study CACHE Child Development and Care Level 2. More details of the course can be found on the CACHE website <https://www.cache.org.uk/about-cache/>

The qualification is in three units:

- An introduction to working with children aged 0-5 years
- Development and well-being 0-5 years
- Child care and development 0-5 years

The first two units are assessed by a graded Assessment Task; and the final unit is a Synoptic Assessment Unit which is assessed via a Multiple Choice Paper. Students will take this paper in March.

We have been doing weekly tests in class to prepare students for this exam. We suggest that they revise by looking at the questions they got wrong in the weekly tests and making revision cards for those questions. They can then test themselves or ask someone to test them. It is important that they do this a number of times.

In the exam they will need an HB pencil and a clean rubber. They will have plenty of time, and so they should read each question carefully and check their answers at the end.
