Small Group Learning

focused on specific areas, e.g. – phonics, spelling, comprehension, Maths.

for public exams, e.g. additional time, reader, use of laptop.

Homework Support –

lunch & after school

1:1 Individualised Intervention

-this could be literacy, maths, social, emotional, ASC, language & communication, health needs, etc.

Provision for ALL Students

Teaching and Learning through appropriate differentiation of curriculum, tasks, materials and outcomes to suit ALL individual learners. School wide learning materials and resources, for example homework club, library resources, subject resources revision sessions, Show My Homework.

Staff training; this includes autism, language and communication and differentiation.

Pastoral system, student support team, PSHE, extra-curricular clubs, enrichment activities, rewards systems, attendance & behaviour policy, etc.

1:1 Key Worker Support

ASC Interventions

Group work to support a range of difficulties, e.g. social communication
